The "Know Your Rights" presentations provide an overview of the current immigration landscape, legal updates, what a person's rights are if he or she encounters immigration enforcement, an overview of the court process, and referrals to legal services providers across Massachusetts. These presentations are targeted to the specific audience and are available in over six languages (including Spanish, Portuguese, and Haitian Creole).
